Challenges to Agency Actions

Mr. Dintzer has extensive experience in challenging agency actions in state court. Representative matters include:

- ▶ ***City of Thousand Oaks v. Regional Water Quality Control Board*** – Represented the City in an appeal of the Regional Board's \$2.3 million fine for a sewage spill resulting from severe El Nino storm conditions. Following the State Water Resources Control Board's refusal to hear any appeal, a petition for writ of mandate was filed in Los Angeles Superior Court. Ultimately, the Regional Board's \$2.3 million fine was overturned.
- ▶ ***Goodrich Corp. v. State Water Resources Control Board, et. al.*** – Represent Goodrich Corporation in a petition for writ of mandate challenging the State Water Resources Control Board authority to proceed in an administrative action and successfully argued that the State Board lacked authority to issue a draft Cleanup and Abatement Order.
