

Gibson Dunn Advises Coterra Energy on \$58 Billion Merger with Devon Energy

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Gibson Dunn is advising Coterra Energy on its all-stock merger agreement with Devon Energy. The combined company's enterprise value will be approximately \$58 billion, making this the largest upstream oil and gas deal since early 2024.
