

Gibson Dunn Guides HPE to Favorable DOJ Settlement in Challenge to HPE-Juniper Merger

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Gibson Dunn successfully represented Hewlett Packard Enterprise (HPE) in securing a settlement with the U.S. Department of Justice (DOJ) that cleared the way for HPE's \$14 billion acquisition of Juniper Networks. HPE announced its agreement to acquire Juniper in January 2024, the DOJ filed suit to block the acquisition in January 2025, and the settlement was reached on June 27, less than two weeks before the scheduled start of trial.
