

Gibson Dunn Named a Law360 Legal Lion of the Week for Patent Win

A Gibson Dunn team has been named a *Law360* Legal Lion of the Week for having an injunction vacated by the U.S. Court of Appeals for the Federal Circuit less than an hour after oral arguments were made by partner Paul Torchia. The injunction had barred our client from launching an alopecia drug due to an alleged patent infringement. The Court indicated that the patent-owner plaintiff would not face irreparable harm because its early-stage drug couldn't be launched until years after the patent expires in 2026. Alongside Paul, our team included partner Charlotte Jacobsen, partner and Co-Chair of the firm's Intellectual Property Practice Group Josh Krevitt, and partners Christine Ranney and Blaine Evanson.
