

Gibson Dunn Secures Spain's €32 Million Arbitration Award Payment in Favor of Basket Renewable Investments

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Gibson Dunn has secured Spain's payment of a €32 million judgment enforcing an arbitration award in favor of our client, Basket Renewable Investments LLC. This marks the first judgment enforcing an arbitration award that Spain has paid. Our firm had won a judgment from the U.S. District Court for the District of Columbia enforcing the award under the ICSID Convention. Spain's payment follows extensive global efforts to identify and pursue its assets after prolonged non-compliance. Spain still owes numerous unpaid awards, and the country is subject to similar enforcement suits — many of them led by Gibson Dunn.
