

Global Arbitration Review Reports Comments Made by Patrick Pearsall on Mandatory Early AI Case Assessments at London International Disputes Week

Patrick proposed inserting a mandatory requirement in arbitration agreements to conduct an early case assessment using artificial intelligence.

Patrick pointed out that we are “no longer asking whether AI case assessments are effective, the market has answered that.” The question is whether arbitration’s procedural architecture should “harness it deliberately, or continue to allow each party to use it privately and asymmetrically.”

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
