

Gregg Costa Speaks With Corporate Counsel About Landmark Decision for In-House Counsel

Gregg, who represented the counsel in the case, said the court correctly recognized that the dispute centered on a legal judgment. "The conduct in this case, advising on whether a termination of a CEO should be for cause, is quintessentially a legal determination, and it's the type of employment decision that lawyers, both in-house and law firm lawyers, make every day in the state of Texas," he said.

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
