Jason noted that while the FTC's non-compete ban has been struck down, the Trump administration remains "skeptical" of the overuse of noncompetes and it would be a mistake to think the administration has no problem with them.

"It's not going to be that every noncompete is illegal, but if you're a company using noncompetes, you'd better be thoughtful about how you do it and make sure that you don't overreach," Jason said.
