Representative matters in which Courtney has been involved include:

- Defeated certification of a class of employees bringing claims under the Uniformed Services Employment and Reemployment Rights Act (*Mahone v. Amazon*).
- Won a complete defense verdict in the Central District of California for an action brought by a former employee alleging whistleblower retaliation and wrongful termination (*Fox v. Harry Winston, Inc.*).
- Core member of the appellate team that secured a reversal of summary judgment at the Hawaii Supreme Court on novel eminent domain issues (*HART v. Victoria Ward*).

Courtney also maintains an active pro bono practice, including civil rights litigation and immigration matters. She was a lead associate of a team that secured a six-figure damages award after a weeklong jury trial in the Central District of California for a man wounded by a rubber bullet while peacefully protesting in Los Angeles (*Jones v. Prior to joining Gibson Dunn, Courtney served as a law clerk to the Honorable Ronald S.W. Lew of the United States District Court for the Central District of California.
