Associate Lindsay Bernsen Wardlaw was quoted by [The Export Practitioner](#) on the U.S. Census Bureau issuing a final rule amending the Foreign Trade Regulations (FTR) to clarify Electronic Export Information (EEI) filing requirements for in-transit shipments that enter the United States before re-export. “The definitions of ultimate consignee and intermediate consignees are now clearer,” Lindsay said. “For example, the existing definition of ultimate consignee was expanded to potentially capture purchasers of the shipment, not just end users and FPPIs (though the FPPI is likely to be either the purchaser or the end user anyway).”
