They examine the Justice Department and Bureau of Industry and Security's (BIS) evolving enforcement focus on export controls — with large corporations being increasingly targeted. To maintain compliance with the shifting enforcement landscape, the article urges companies to “take a more intentional approach in assessing their enforcement risk and compliance posture,” including a review of export compliance programs to ensure they capture relevant regulatory requirements and reflect this new era of heightened enforcement risk.

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
