

Joseph Warin wins Who's Who Legal Investigations Lawyer of the Year

Gibson Dunn & Crutcher partner F Joseph Warin has been named Who's Who Legal Investigations Lawyer of the Year.

Warin, based in Washington, DC, becomes the first lawyer to win the award for the field of investigations. He received the most votes from practitioners and clients for his work as an investigations lawyer.

Who's Who Legal lists the leading lawyers in different practice areas, from antitrust to mergers and acquisitions. This was the first year that an award was given for investigations, which focuses on practitioners working on international cases involving bribery, fraud and sanctions, among other areas.

Warin said: "I'm pleased to be given the award, which also reflects the quality of the global team assembled here at Gibson Dunn and the work that we do together."

"We are honoured to be entrusted by clients to handle investigations that threaten the very essence of their existence," he added.

In total, 343 lawyers were listed in the Who's Who Legal of Investigations from countries including the UK, United States, United Arab Emirates and Brazil. Warin came top for his work in advising companies on large-scale investigations in areas such as FCPA, antitrust and securities enforcement.

Warin advised oil and gas services company Weatherford International on its US\$253 million settlement of FCPA charges brought by the US Department of Justice and Securities & Exchange Commission. He also continues to act as counsel to technology company Hewlett Packard on a current FCPA investigation. In two separate FCPA cases, Warin acted as compliance monitor to Statoil and as counsel to the compliance monitor to Siemens.
